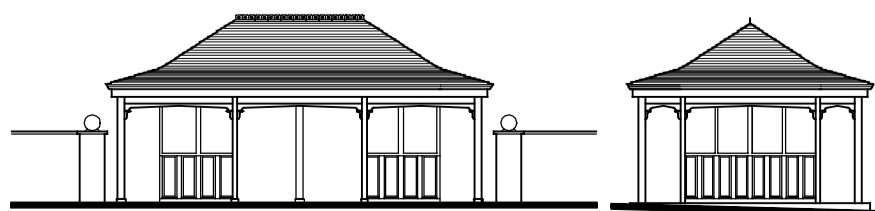

OUTLINE SCHEDULE OF WORKS

Overhaul existing roof with new felt underlay, re-fix existing plain and feature ridge tiles

Renew/reinstate timber boarded soffits, all to match existing

Renew/reinstate all timber fascias and mouldings profiled to match the existing

Renew all timber supporting posts together with their plinth bases, install new central column to match existing

Remove central non structural sections, together with the glazed areas and built-in seating, remove all glazing and make good frames

Clad retained structural elements with timber panelling to match existing

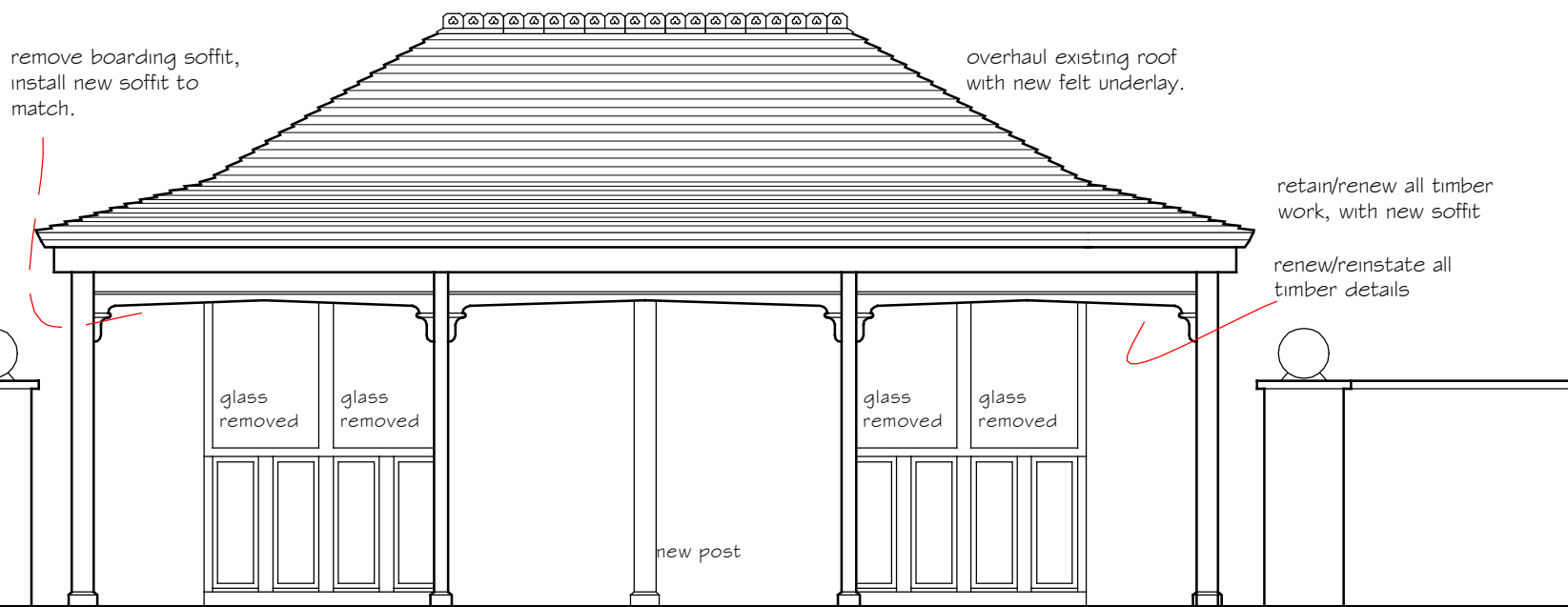
Colours to be as noted on the drawings

Take up and re-lay paving to beneath footprint of shelter

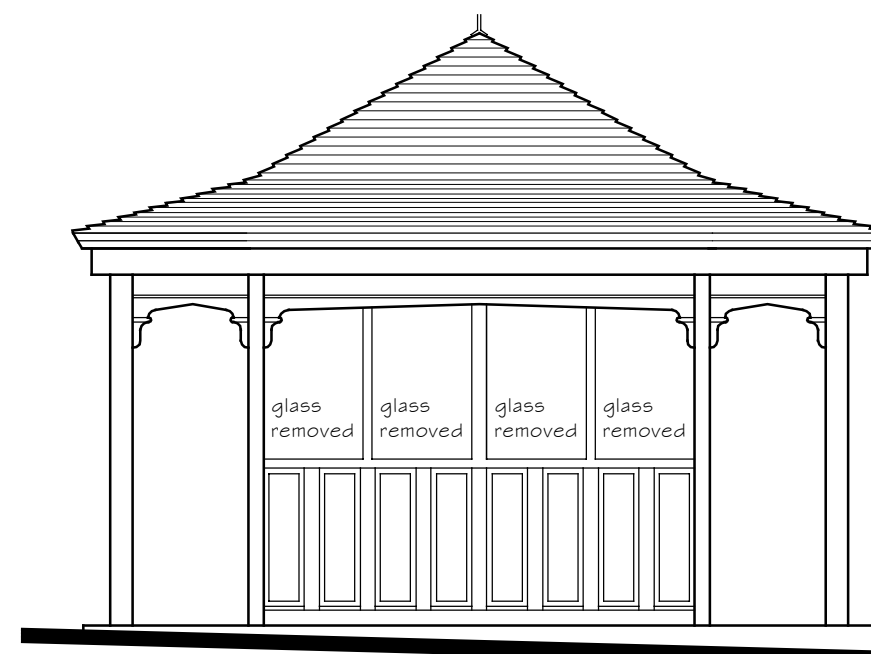

shelter from road



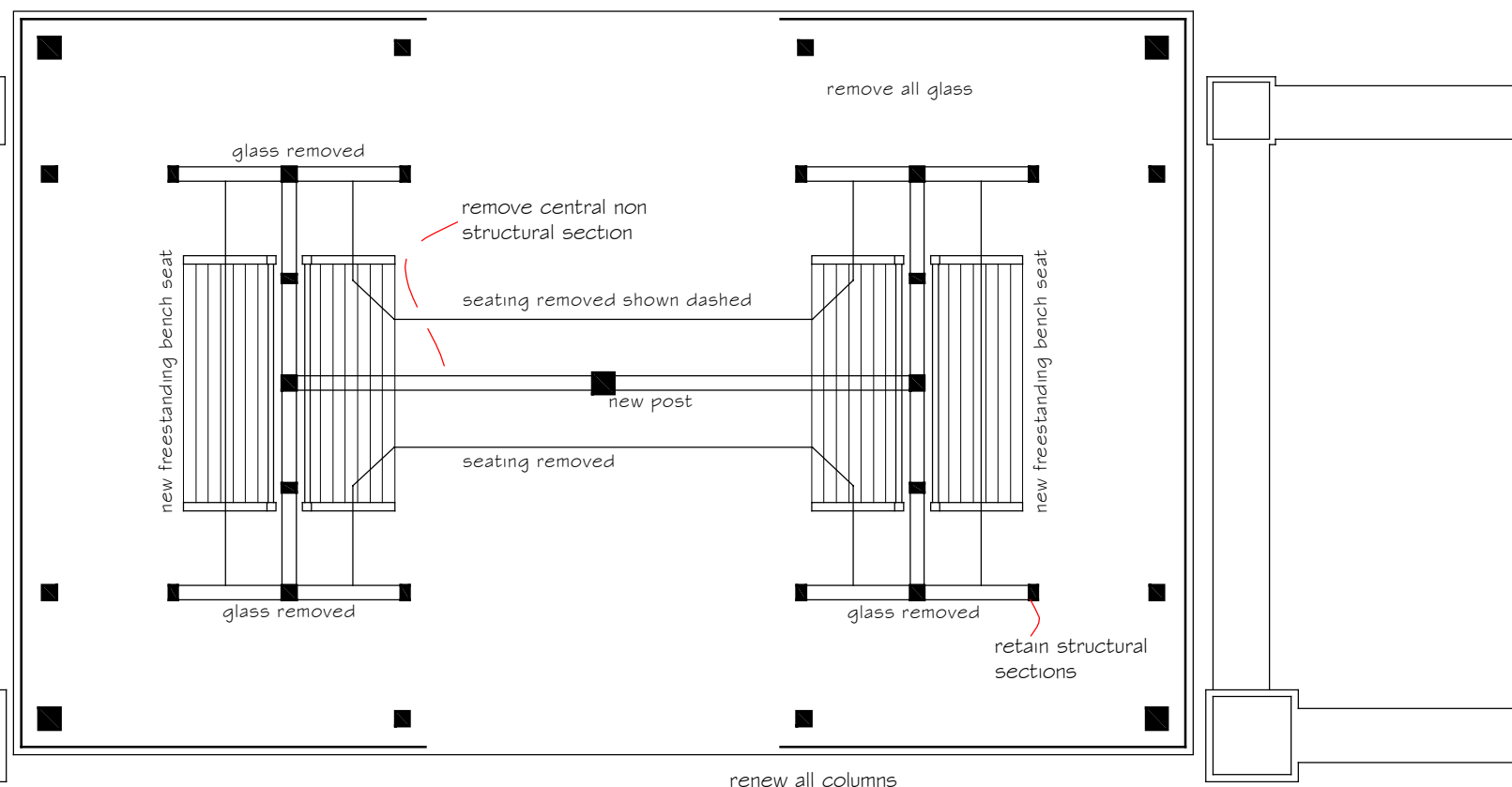
end elevation

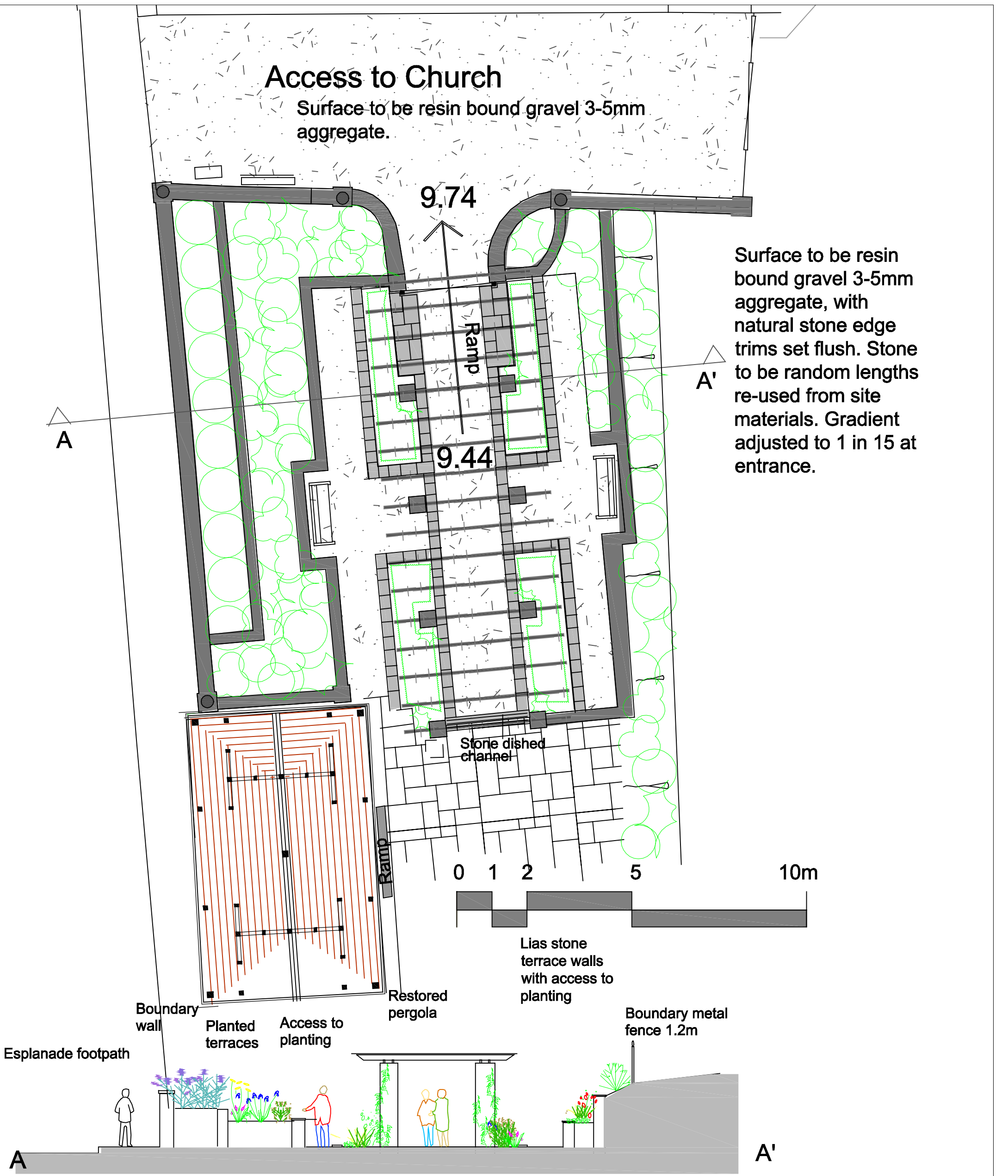

Access to Church

Surface to be resin bound gravel 3-5mm aggregate.



Surface to be resin bound gravel 3-5mm aggregate, with natural stone edge trims set flush. Stone to be random lengths re-used from site materials. Gradient adjusted to 1 in 15 at entrance.

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
